HAUPTSTEIN OPENS XXLKW SECURE TRUCK PARKING AREA



Hauptstein ImmoBau GmbH officially opened the XXLKW truck parking area on December 1, 2022, in a "soft opening". With this soft opening, 107 parking spaces are currently available and in the coming months, the parking area will gradually make all the services they have planned available for customers. Eventually, 350 parking spaces will be open to customers.

The secure truck parking lot is 800 meters from the Vockerode motorway exit in Saxony-Anhalt (A9 Munich – Berlin). The location is quiet and yet close to the motorway.



On December 12, 2022, Calsina Carré hosted a successful kick-off event at their site in Pont de Molins to officially launch their multi-million CEF-funded project to build a safe and secure parking area as well as celebrate the Calsina Carré Services Project. They invited several important stakeholders. Speakers included Josep Maria Carré, one of the owners of Calsina Carré: Pau Presas, the Vice President of the Diputació de Girona; Albert Bramón, the Sub-Delegate of the Spanish Government in Girona; Josep Fuentes, the Mayor of Pont du Molins; and Roger Torrent, the Councilor of Enterprise and Labor. In addition, ESPORG General Manager Dirk Penasse, along with several other representatives of invested stakeholders, participated in the round table event titled "The Role of Parking in the Future of Mobility." Calsina Carré invests 25 million euros to create a parking lot for 400 trucks in Pont de Molins

The Calsina Carré Services project aims to be a benchmark for hauli- ers in a 95.000 square meter area.

In its 50th birthday year, the company launches a pioneering service equipped with modules, snack vending, showers, laundry room, leI-luggage office, rest area and 24/7 video surveillance.

Pont de Molins, December 12, 2022 - The family-owned mul1na1onal Calsina Carré has created Calsina Carré Services to offer a parking lot for 400 trucks at its headquarters in Pont de Molins (Alt Empordà) and become a benchmark for external hauliers and drivers. In the year of its 50th birthday, the Catalan company promotes Services, with an investment of 25 million euros to be made between 2022 and 2027, to offer an innova1ve and quality service to carri- ers, with equipment such as: lockers, video surveillance, showers and toilets, laundry, rest area, wifi connec1on, vending machines and its own gas sta1on.

In total, there are now 400 parking spaces in a space of 95,000 square meters and the forecast is to expand by 200 more spaces in 2023, more

than 100 spaces in 2025 and 120 more in 2027. In total, by 2027 there will be more than 800 parking spaces on 150,000 square meters. The company's management believes that its knowledge of the sector as a fleet operator brings a lot of value to the challenge of Services as a strategic center in the Mediterranean corridor, 15 kilometers from the French border and close to Vilamalla.

Calsina Carré Services is one of the largest parking lots for hauliers in the province of Girona. The 25 million investment will allow the company to be a reference beyond transport and logis1cs and to become in the future an opera1onal base for external truckers and drivers. Both for those who want to enter Catalan and Spanish territory and those who want to go abroad due to the proximity to the border. "It is a very important and strategic commitment. It is an investment of 25 million to posi1on Calsina Carré as a logis1cs hub of reference in the Mediterranean corridor, which contributes to dignify the condi1ons of carriers," said the general manager, Alba Carré, who has held the posi1on for 5 years and is part of the third generalon of the family.

Alba Carré considers that the future of Calsina Carré is based on the Services concept "to become one of the largest security parking lots for hauliers in Spain, and we will do so by offering a wide range of quality services for the driver and vehicle maintenance". In the future, Calsina Carré Services will also have a restaurant and a gymnasium in the same complex in Pont de Molins.

50 years of history of Calsina Carré

The family-owned mul1na1onal of reference in the transport sector, Calsina Carré, based in Pont de Molins, celebrates half a century of existence and ac1vity and does so with the second and third generalons leading the project and maintaining the same entrepreneurial spirit of its founders. The Girona-based company has a strong internalonal presence a^er having sought new opportuniles and diversified its investments. As a result, Calsina Carré has a turnover of more than 150 million euros. employs more than 700 workers, has a fleet of 1.000 vehicles and works with reference clients in sectors such as the automolve, chemical, industrial and food industries. To reach these figures, the company has followed a path based on the voca1on of service and the will to expand its services. Within this framework of ac1on, the company has opened several warehouses throughout Europe and the Maghreb. It also has offices in Bar- celona. Valls. Venlo (Netherlands), Tunis (Tunis), Tangier (Morocco) and Pites1 (Romania).





MILENCE: DEDICATED TO MAKING THE FUTURE OF ROAD TRANS-PORT FOSSIL-FREE

The European Secure Parking Organisation has welcomed a new associated member, Milence, to its network. ESPORG firmly believes in the mission of Milence and in their approach to supporting the transition to zero-emission heavy-duty vehicles in Europe. "We are always saying that we need to focus on alternative energy solutions, but the reality is that the market is slow-moving. Milence was needed five to ten years ago so that companies and drivers could have the charging solutions they need. I'm really happy that they are taking the initiative to offer practical solutions now so that drivers can safely and sustainably do their jobs," says General Manager Dirk Penasse.

About Milence:

Milence is a joint venture formed by Volvo Group, Daimler Truck, and TRATON GROUP, which was established in 2022 and is dedicated to making the future of road transport fossil-free. With 500 million euros in initial funding, they aim to deliver sustainable energy for all battery-electric heavy-duty vehicles by rolling out a large-scale public charging network.

They will build and operate at least 1,700 public charge points in Europe by 2027. Milence will initially focus on charging locations in the Netherlands, Germany, France, Belgium, Spain, Italy, Norway, and Sweden. They will also build charging locations in the United Kingdom, Denmark, Poland, Austria, Czechia, Switzerland, and Portugal in the coming five years.

Building confidence in the market

The network rollout strategy for Milence focuses on building confidence and enhancing trust in the market. Trucks have to be able to charge when they need to—which means reliable charge points which are available and functioning.

So how will Milence do this? This is their promise:

- 1. Think ahead:
- Milence will always build charging locations so that they are in place before they are needed. To do this, they will focus on data, adapting to growth in the market.
- They will focus on having chargers close to large transport hubs and along the most frequented highways, starting where battery electric trucks are expected to be deployed first.
- 2. Build modularly. Milence will begin with small sites which can then be expanded as demand grows.
- 3. Be transparent: to build up trust, Milence believes in transparency regarding their network rollout. This includes notifying the public about future locations as soon as they can in order to help transport companies take these locations into account as they plan the electrification of trucks.

Transforming the Industry

Milence is looking at transforming the transport and logistics industry in a way that will protect drivers, conserve energy, and lower costs.

"With favourable EU regulations, lower costs of ownership, improved working conditions for truck drivers, and the rollout of a Europe-wide megawatt charging network, we expect battery-electric trucking to transform the road transport industry in the coming years," says Anja van Niersen, CEO of Milence.

- Within two to four years, electric trucks will have a lower total cost of ownership (TCO) than diesel trucks for a broad range of transports, including long haulage.
- To improve driver working conditions, Milence will ensure that charging sites are safe, secure, and offer facilities and services suited to drivers' needs. These

- include clean sanitation facilities, food and beverage services, recreation facilities and a high level of security.
- In the current energy transition, it is important to use the available energy as efficiently as possible. Furthermore, onsite batteries at charging stations will enable trucks to utilise stored green energy, decreasing peak energy demand. In this way Milence can reduce electrical grid congestion, balancing the demand and offering a pragmatic solution for the current grid congestion in many countries.
- While the current charging standard (CCS) already enables some heavy-duty trucks to fully charge in under 90 minutes, the new Megawatt Charging System (MCS) which Milence will utilize will make it possible to charge a 40-tonne truck in 30-45 minutes while drivers take their mandatory break.
